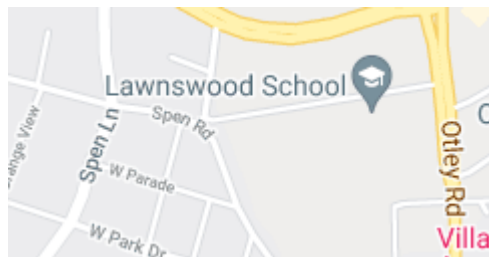
We are a family run private day nursery set in far Headingley/ West Park in North Leeds. We were first established in 2005 and have since grown to the 50 place nursery we are today.
